## PROJECT OUTCOMES FOR COUNCILS

- In December 2014, Lismore City Council adopted a Renewable Energy Master Plan with a goal to self-generate all their electricity from renewable sources by 2023.
- In October 2017, Port Macquarie Hastings Council resolved to adopt the Long-Term Energy Strategy, and to “pursue and implement the most cost-effective energy projects over a long-term period”.
- In April 2016, Coffs Harbour Council adopted a strategy aimed at using 100% renewable energy in all Council facilities by 2030, plus a target of 50% GHG reduction on 2010 levels by 2025.
- In November 2017, Tweed Shire Council adopted a long-term renewable energy action plan (REAP), with a target to produce 25% of its own electricity from renewable sources by 2022, and 50% by 2025.

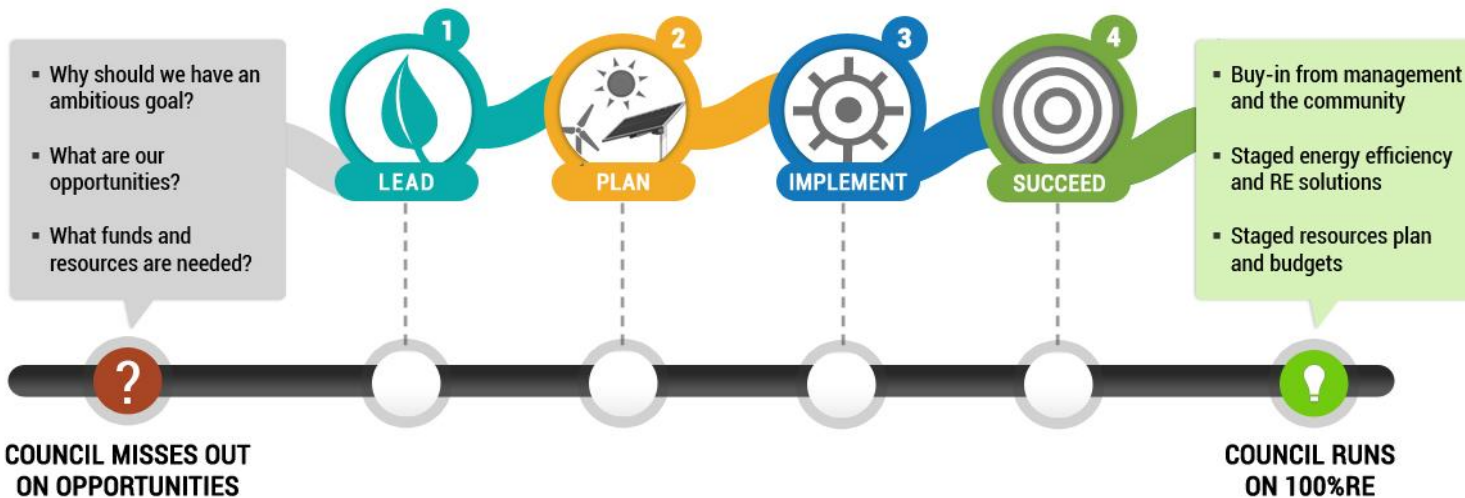

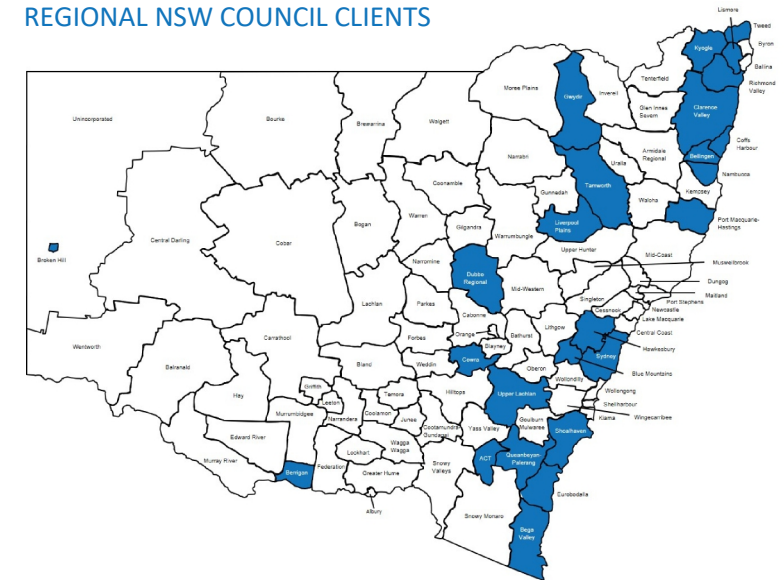
